4. Bobby Kinch – New National Oath Keepers President

Bobby Kinch, the new National Oath Keeper President, joined the call to discuss the new direction National was taking. Bobby is an Air Force Vet and a retired police officer. He joined National Oath Keepers in 2019. He also served as Oath Keeper State President and was a National Oath Keeper Board member.

Bobby stated they've basically had to start the organization over again and build it from the ground up. The new name is Oath Keepers USA. Bobby recognized that in the past that State



Oath Keeper organizations received no support from National and he intends on changing that. He also said he would like to see Oath Keepers become more involved in vetting and promoting Constitutional politicians.

Former lifetime members of the National Oath Keepers will be honored in the new organization however everyone will go through the vetting process again. Bobby stated they have access to the membership list from the prior organization and all of those former members will be contacted when SOP's are established. He also informed us that members are welcome to attend the National Oath Keeper Board calls upon request.

5. Mailing of the Letter to Membership

The Board will utilize Laurie and Troy Damalak's printing business for stationery and mailing supplies.

Nick recommended that we start utilizing CPanel email vs Vertical Response to send out messages to members. Nick will be looking into both platforms more to identify the best course of action.
